**2. INTRODUCTION TO THE IWI MANAGEMENT PLAN**

The Council has statutory obligations under the Local Government Act and the Resource Management Act to appropriately recognise, protect and provide for tangata whenua values and interests. An iwi management plan (IMP) is a tangata whenua planning tool that assists Councils to do this, and there are specific requirements to take an Iwi Management Plan into account when preparing or changing district plans.
