1.1 New Zealand Transport Agency (NZTA) Quarterly Update

The Board was advised that the "tidal flow" traffic management for Curletts Road between Blenheim Road and Main South Road was proving extremely expensive for NZTA. 10. 341 – 345 RICCARTON ROAD – PROPOSED NO STOPPING RESTRICTION

The Board considered a report seeking the Riccarton/Wigram Community Board's approval to install a no stopping restriction between 341 and 345 Riccarton Road.

The Board **resolved** to approve:

- (a) That all existing parking restrictions on the southern side of Riccarton Road commencing at its intersection with Auburn Avenue and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 101 metres be revoked.
- (b) That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the southern side of Riccarton Road commencing at its intersection with Auburn Avenue and extending in a easterly direction for a distance of 101 metres.

- (a) That the stopping of vehicles currently prohibited at any time on the east side of Shand Crescent commencing at it's eastern intersection with Riccarton Road and continuing in a southerly direction for a distance of six metres be revoked.
- (b) That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the east side of Shand Crescent commencing at it's eastern intersection with Riccarton Road and continuing in a southerly direction for a distance of 43 metres.

The Board **requested** a staff report on traffic management to mitigate heavy transport parking outside residents' houses on Racecourse Road between Thornhill Place and Epsom Road.
