The purpose of this report is to present a memorandum from the General Manager City Environment requiring a resolution for an amended location with Latimer Square for the Spire Sculpture.

Background:

At the Council meeting of 24 April 2013 a report on the proposed location and temporary licence for the Spire Sculpture was presented:

*It was **resolved** on the motion of the Mayor, seconded by Councillor Reid, that the Council approve a temporary Licence to Lewis Bradford Consulting Engineers to install and maintain a 'spire' sculpture, subject to the applicant obtaining Building and Resource Consents, insurances and providing funding for the installation and maintenance of the sculpture for the licensed period. The licence is for a period of three years from installation and for a total area of 144 square metres situated at the eastern side, of the central west to east footpath through Latimer Square.*

Upon further investigation of the approved location for the Spire Sculpture, Lewis Bradford Consulting Engineers have found that the site has gas, high voltage cables and fibre optic cables within the vicinity of the proposed foundations for the sculpture (refer Figure 1).

Taking into consideration the numerous underground services within the area for the proposed sculpture foundations, Lewis Bradford Consulting Engineers have requested that an alternative location be considered (refer Figure 2).

The alternative location is on the south eastern side, of the southern square in Latimer Square. This proposed location is clear of any services, approximately 5 metres to nearest pipe, and away from any trees.

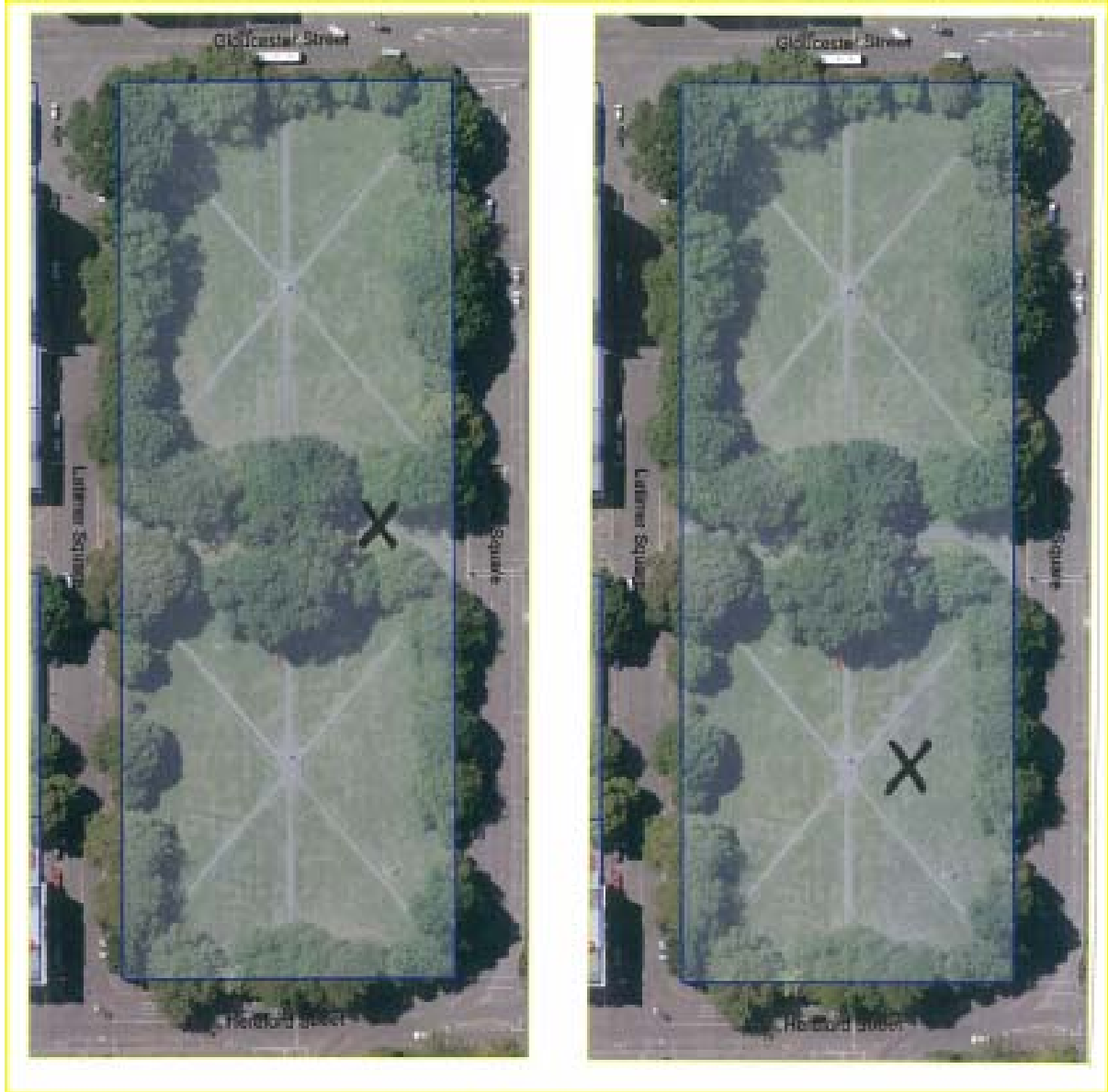
The internal stakeholders are in favour of the alternative location and the and the Christchurch Club have also confirmed that they are comfortable with the change in location. We anticipate that the Cathedral Chapter will also be happy with the location identified.

Further consideration has also been given to the appropriate funding mechanism for the building consent process to support the project. It is now proposed that the "transitional city" budget will cover these building consent costs.
