2. SOCIAL HOUSING REFORM BILL

Presenters: Paul Cottam, Principal Advisor Social Policy and Alan Bywater, Strategic Policy Unit Manager.

Purpose: The Government has introduced the Social Housing Reform (Housing Restructuring and Tenancy Matters Amendment) Bill. The Bill could have significant impact on the future operation of the Council's social housing. The workshop will consist of an explanation of what is in the Bill, consider its implications for the Council and the content of a Council submission.

3. FANFARE SCULPTURE (IF AVAILABLE)

Presenters: Deborah McCormick, Director of SCAPE Public Art; Neil Dawson, Artist; and Hugh Nicholson, Principal Adviser Urban Design

Purpose: Christchurch City Council in partnership with SCAPE Public Art have been investigating options for locating the artwork Fanfare since it was gifted to the Council in 2005. Fanfare was created by Christchurch artist Neil Dawson and originally commissioned for New Year celebrations in Sydney Australia. This work to find a location for the sculpture has included consideration of location, impact on the natural environment and ecology, acoustic issues, engineering and braking systems for the moving elements of the work, and consultation with various stakeholders including hapu, Christchurch International Airport, New Zealand Transport Agency and neighbouring businesses and landowners. In this workshop staff will review the investigation work and discuss options for siting the artwork with Councillors.
