**9.1 CAPITAL WORKS ON ILAM AND CLYDE ROADS**

The Board noted its concern that major road works have been commenced at the same time on Ilam and Clyde Roads, two major roadways, adding to traffic congestion.

**9.2 UPPER RICCARTON TEMPORARY LIQUOR BAN AREA EXTENSION**

The Board were advised that the request of the Ilam Upper Riccarton Residents' Association and the Board to have a temporary liquor ban in the area bounded by Peer Street, Waimairi Road, Maidstone Road, Avonhead Road, and Yaldhurst Road had been approved by the Council.

**9.3 RUAPUNA PLAN CHANGE 52**

The Board were advised the Council had considered the Commissioner's Report on Ruapuna Plan Change 52 – Management of Noise. Details of the Report would be released shortly.

**9.4 RESILIENT CITIES – UNITED NATIONS**

The Board questioned whether the Council had given any feedback or action on the document on the United Nations Resilient Cities Project that was tabled during the Board's submission to the Council's Draft Three Year Plan. The Board **requested** that the tabled document be sent to all elected members to consider.

**9.5 MUIR PARK**

The Board enquired when the Board's 28 May 2013 requested site visit to Muir Park would occur. The Board were advised that the planning for the visit was progressing. The Board were reminded that the trees canopies, on the south boundary adjacent to 514 Halswell Road, were pruned and lifted after the last Board's site visit in approximately 2009.

**9.6 BUS SHELTERS IN BUCHANANS ROAD**

The Board enquired about the Riccarton Park Residents' Association request for bus shelters to be installed in Buchanans Road near Racecourse Road. The Board were advised that the shelters would be installed.
