Purpose of this Memo:

To provide the Board with an update on the proposed purchase of the property at 253 QEII Drive following further negotiations with the vendor.

Background:

The Shirley/Papanui Community Board considered a report regarding the purchase of the property at 253 QEII Drive on 6 May 2015.

The Board's decision at this meeting was as follows:

"FOLLOWING DISCUSSION THE SHIRLEY/PAPANUI COMMUNITY BOARD DECIDED TO LAY THE REPORT ON THE TABLE AND REQUESTED THAT STAFF PROVIDE FURTHER INFORMATION ON THE FLOODING REMEDIATION PLAN, AND THE NECESSITY TO THAT PLAN OF THE PURCHASE OF THIS PARTICULAR PROPERTY, AT THE BOARD'S NEXT MEETING ON 20 MAY 2015"


The additional information requested by the Board was subsequently presented by members of Council's Three Waters and Waste Unit.

A revised valuation from Council's appointed valuer which took into consideration the recent sale of the adjoining property, 281 QEII Drive, indicated that the market value for 253 QEII Drive is significantly less than the amount originally offered by Council.

As a result of the revised valuation further negotiations took place with the vendor based on the revised market value for the property. Unfortunately an agreement was not reached and the owner decided to no longer proceed with the discussions.


Conclusion:

That the report currently on the table awaiting for the outcome of the negotiations with the vendor be withdrawn as an agreement on the purchase price could not be reached.
