## **Committee Comment**

Keith Tallentire and Cameron Wood, Senior Policy Planner – Waimakariri District Council - introduced this item. During the discussion the following points were raised:

- 1. Committee members acknowledged the significant volume of work that was done by staff to produce the report.
- 2. Additional commentary on the implications of the results will come when more work has been done allowing trends to become clearer.
- 3. The Committee expressed concern that some indicators used might not be the most suitable or accurately illustrate the situation. Housing affordability was posed as one indicator that can be distorted by a number of other factors depending on how it is measured.
  - a. Staff agreed that the methodology behind some of the data needs to improve and this issue is being looked at. Conversely, a degree of consistency in methodology over time is important to maintain the integrity of trend analysis.
