

3. Key Points

- 3.1 Public consultation was carried out through standard channels with the period of time allowing for objections to be received meeting the minimum time period of 1 week.
- 3.2 No Objections were received from the Consultation
- 3.3 There is only one direct vehicle access way onto the section of road proposed to be closed, Park Lane Retirement Village. This property has an alternative access from Whiteleigh Avenue that will be unimpeded by the proposed closure.
- 3.4 The Event organisers have contacted the local residents, via letter drop, on 4 August to provide details of the proposed closures and to provide an opportunity to engage with them should residents have any issues. At the time of writing this report no contact had been made with the event organisers by any residents.

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- 3.5 This event has occurred in this location previously with no known issues occurring.


