# Committee Resolved PRSC/2018/00017

# Part C

That the Parking Restrictions Subcommittee:

- Approve that any parking or stopping restrictions on the north side of Cambridge Terrace, commencing at its intersection with Manchester Street and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 51.5 metres be revoked.
- 2. Approve that the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the north side of Cambridge Terrace commencing at its intersection with Manchester Street and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 18 metres.
- Approve that the parking of vehicles be restricted to a maximum period of 120 minutes on the north side of Cambridge Terrace, commencing at a point 18 metres east of its intersection with Manchester Street and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 18 metres.
- 4. Approve that the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the north side of Cambridge Terrace commencing at a point 36 metres east of its intersection with Manchester Street and extending in an easterly, the north easterly direction for a distance of 15.5 metres.
