2. Approves that all existing parking and stopping restrictions on the south side of Prestons Road commencing at its intersection with Walters Road and extending in a westerly direction to its intersection with Hills Road be revoked.
3. Approves, pursuant to Clause 7 of the Christchurch City Council Traffic and Parking Bylaw 2017, that the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the south side of Prestons Road commencing at its intersection with Marshland Road and extending in a westerly direction for a distance of 58 metres.
4.
