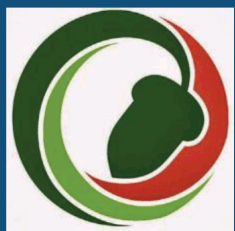

- Respect the birdlife



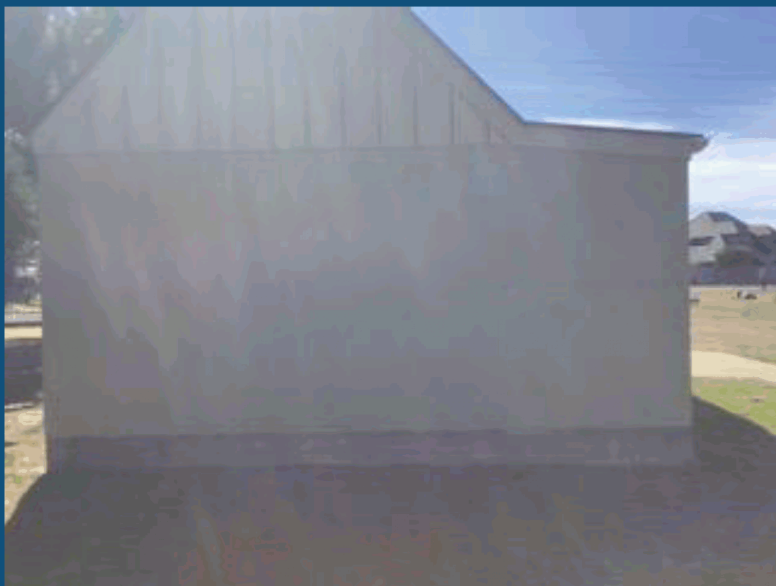
Create new signage about the Wildlife at Westlake
