## Budgeting and Funding

### Estimated Budget

• Engineer Costs -	\$24,480
• Pavilion Installation -	\$19,711
• Shipping and Transportation -	\$29,157
• Pavilion -	\$20,182
• Plaques -	\$1,783
• Events (Unveiling) -	\$767
• Overhead Calculation (15%) -	\$14,412
