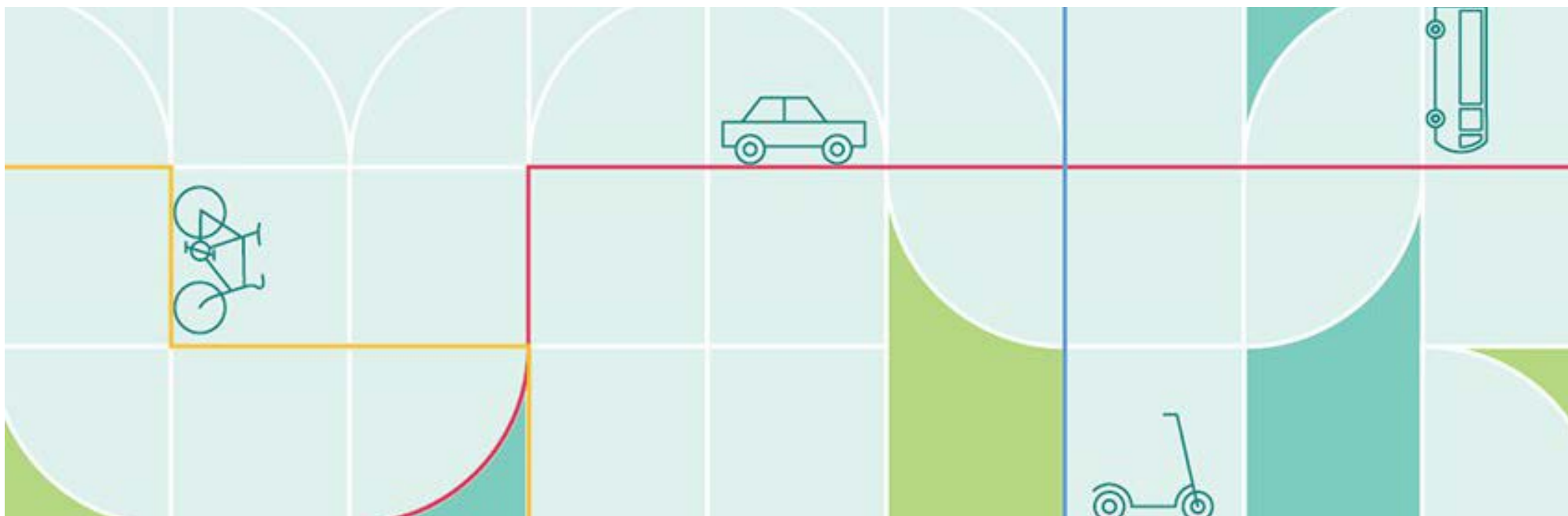

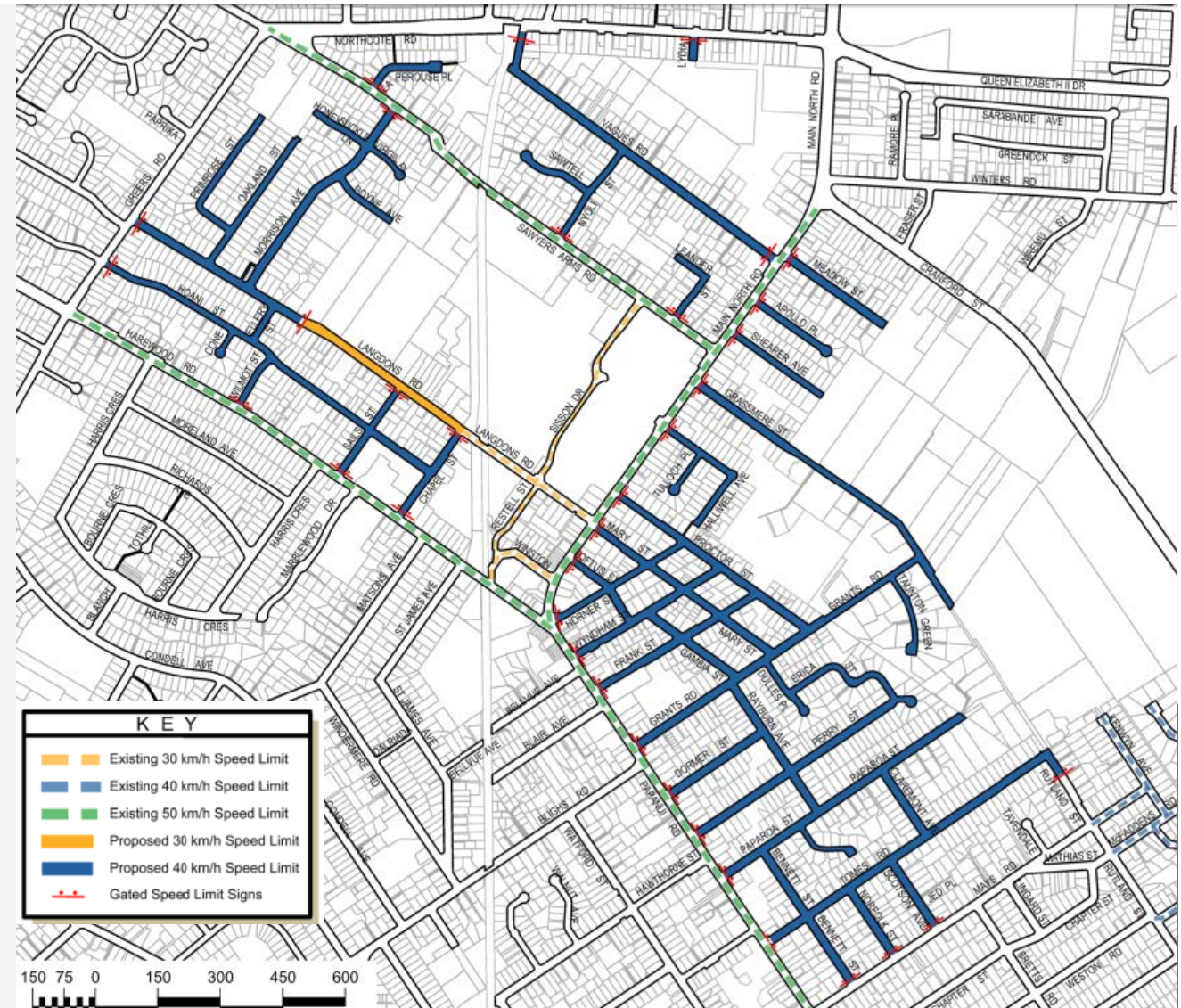
Why review speeds in neighbourhoods?

- *Road to Zero has set a goal of a 40% reduction in Death and Serious injury crashes by 2030*
- *Speed management is one of the many tools being used to achieve this*
- *Safe and appropriate speeds in neighbourhoods can:*
 - Improve safety for vulnerable road users
 - Improve connectivity for pedestrians
 - Reduce traffic noise in communities
 - Improve safety outside schools in these neighbourhoods

What was consulted on

- 40km/h for neighbourhood streets
- 30km/h for busy commercial area around shopping centre
- Bound by main roads
