Part A

2. Recommends that the Council:
 - a. Approves the adoption of Option 1: spray and drip irrigate treated wastewater to the Akaroa Golf Course.
 - b. Requests Officers incorporate provision for future non-potable reuse.
 - c. Supports a long term lease for the Akaroa Golf Club.
 - d. Makes provision in the LTP for increased operational costs for the Akaroa Golf Club associated with the needs of the scheme.
 - e. Requests that Officers work closely with the Ōnuku Rūnanga, Akaroa Golf Club, Duvauchelle Primary School and Banks Peninsula Early Learning Incorporated and Trust during the design development and resource consent process.
 - f. Requests as a minimum that the resource consent application is limited notified.
 - g. Notes other concerns raised by submitters about potential environmental effects will be addressed through the resource consent process.
