### Development and improvement of recreational spaces in Halswell

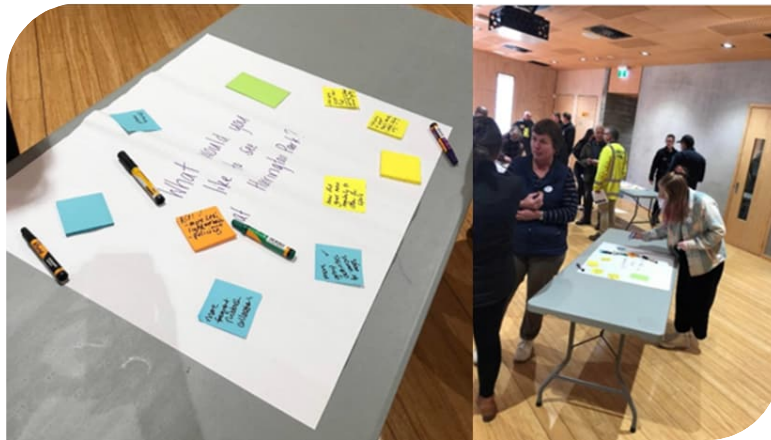
The project to supply accessible play equipment for Halswell Domain continues to be delayed by supply chain issues.
