7. Consideration and Deliberation Ngā Whaiwhakaaro me Ngā Taukume o Ngā Kōrero

The Hearings Panel considered and deliberated on the written and verbal submissions received and additional information provided by submitters and Council Officers.

Council Officers Robbie Hewson and Antony Shadbolt returned to the table to respond to questions raised by the Hearings Panel.

The Panel noted the following matters relating to the Roto Kohatu Reserve Management Plan:

- A wide range of recreational and active users
- Anti-social behaviour
- Road Access
- Parking
- Toilet and shower areas
- Flocking birds
- Water quality
- Shade sails

In considering these matters the Panel noted the following answers received from staff relating to these items:

- Security cameras have been installed in the area as well as building a working relationship with Community Patrol in the area.
- No further parking is required as the current parking is adequate and such management would put more pressure on the environment.
- The gravel road across the top of the Reserve will be closing, however a new road access
 will be opening. The new entry points to the Reserve will be able to be used by a wide range
 of users and vehicles including wide vans and trucks and trailers.
- Toilet and showers are currently installed, open and operating.
- Planting tall trees and vegetation can have an impact on dissuading flocking birds from the area.
- The water quality of the Reserve is monitored annually.
- There are ongoing discussions with an organisation which is interested in funding shade sails for to be used at the Reserve.



In response to queries raised in the hearing staff agreed to inquire into/carry out the following actions:

- Send Ingrid Robertson and Chris Ford details of the upcoming Waimāero Fendalton-Waimairi-Harewood Community Board meeting 12 September.
- Investigate installing mounted sunscreen dispensers.
- Send Simon Rutherford details of the upcoming Waimāero Fendalton-Waimairi-Harewood Community Board meeting 12 September.
- Investigate installing speed bump on the new access road.
