The Ōpāwaho Heathcote River Network (OHRN) is a community-based catchment group.

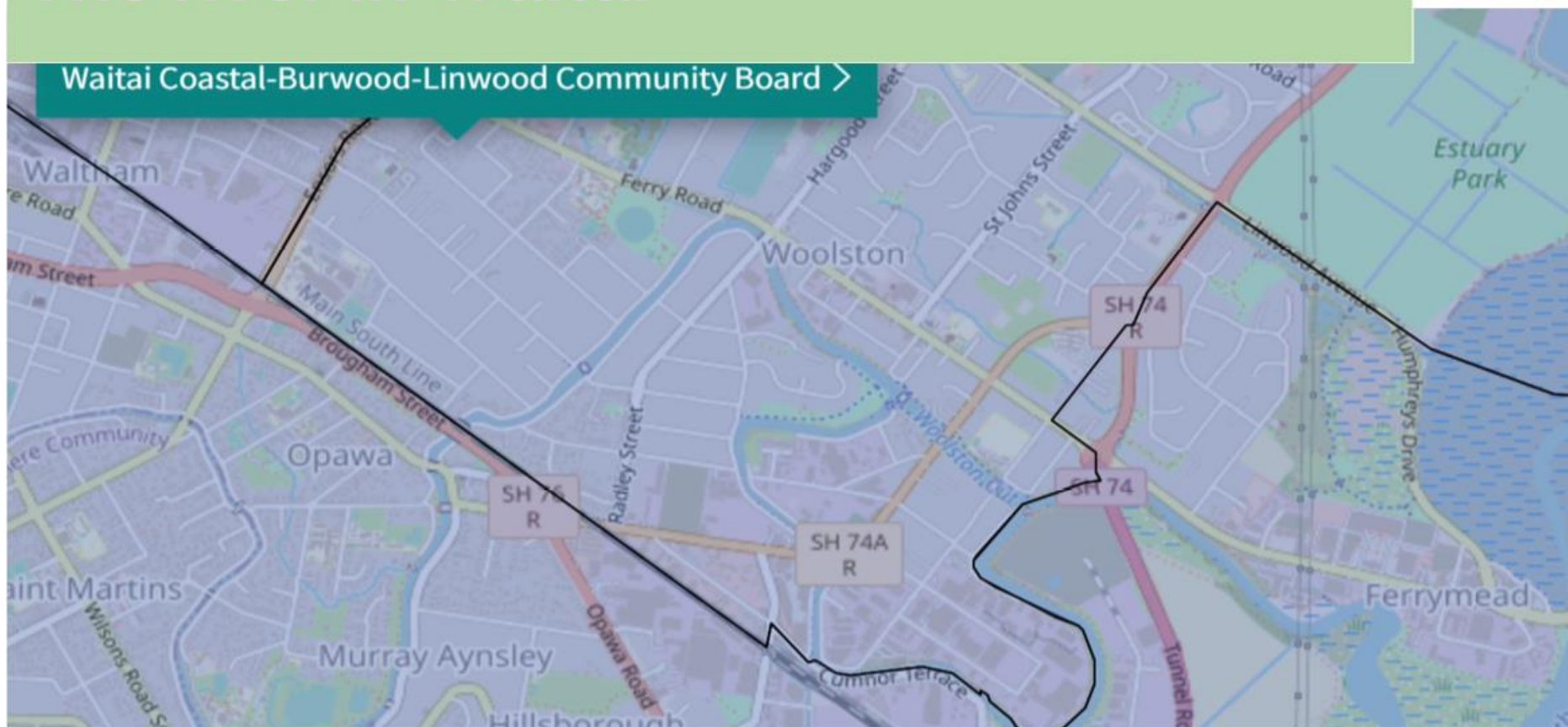
**The OHRN is a voice for the river.**
