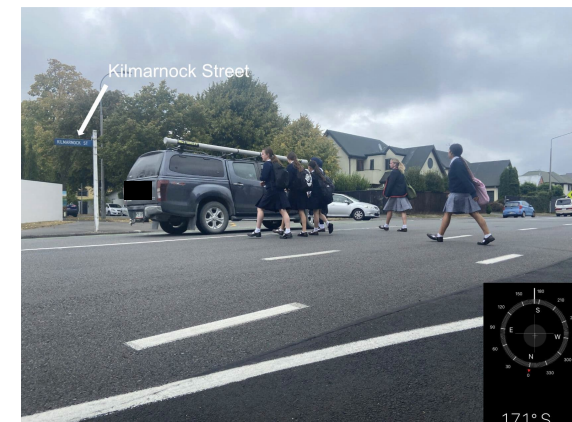
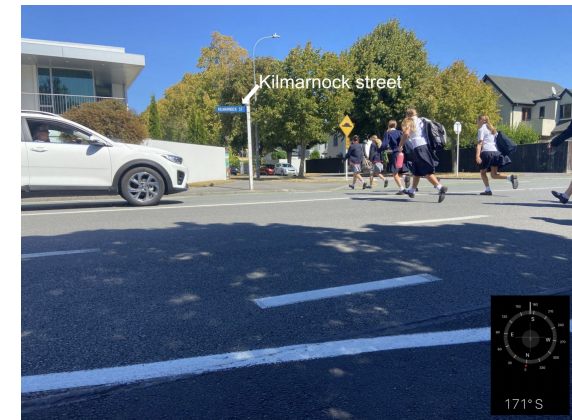

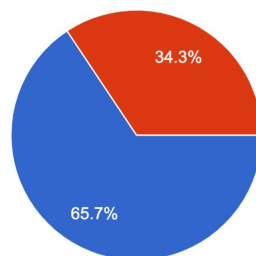

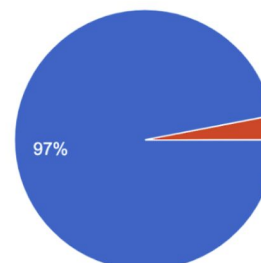

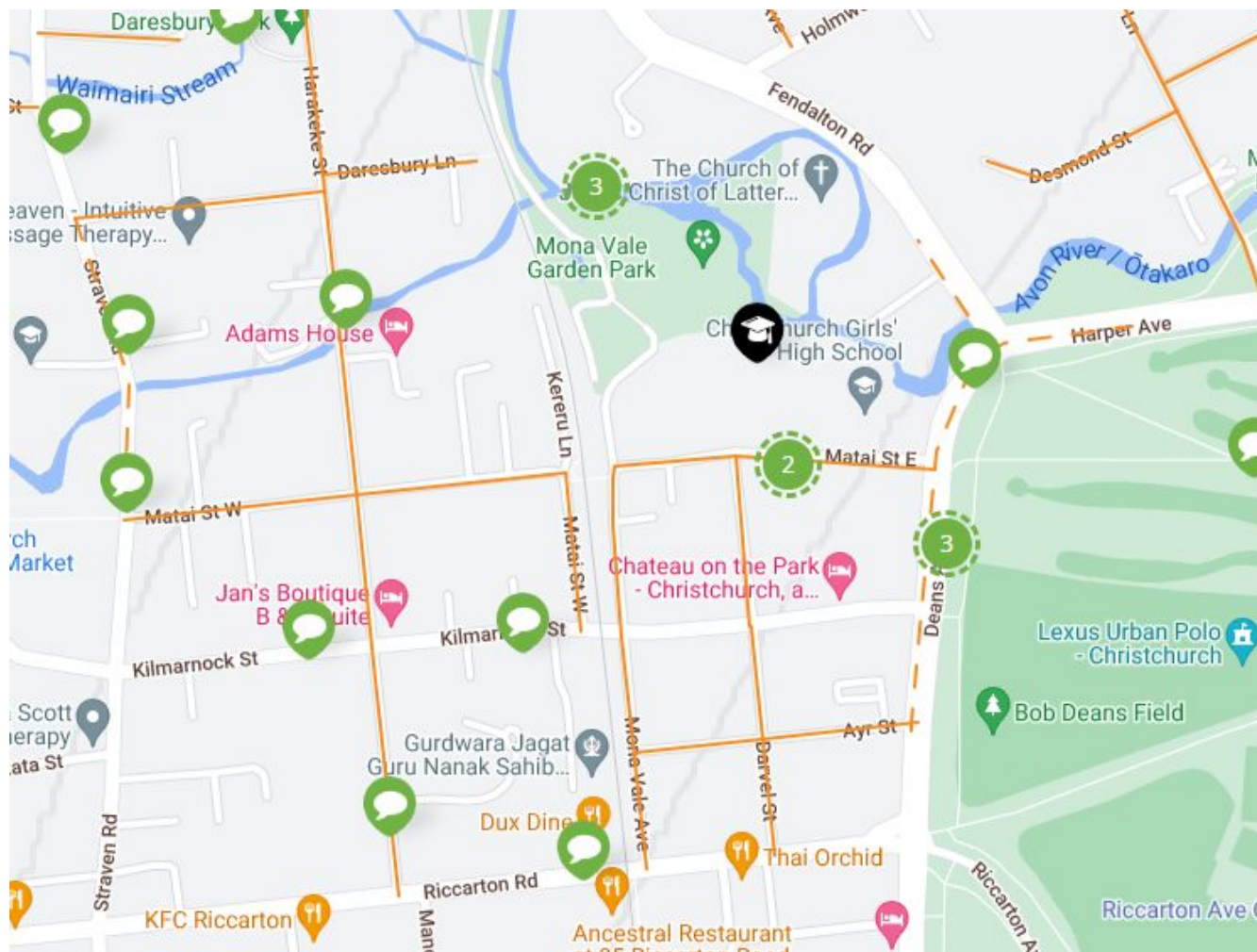

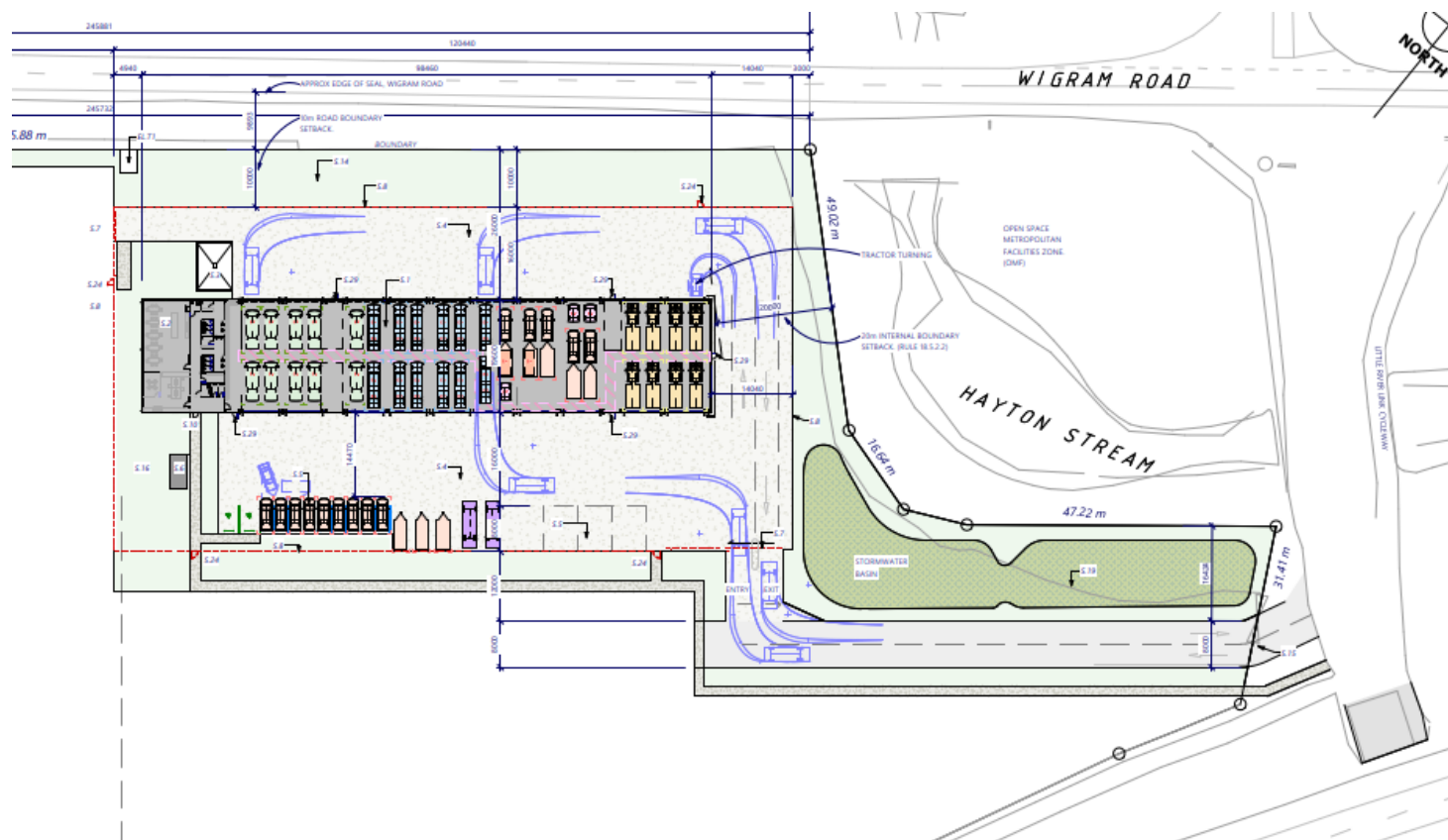


## Proposed Depot location
