The agenda was dealt with in the following order.

1. Apologies Ngā Whakapāha

An apology for absence from Jake McLellan was received.

2. Update for the Public Consultation for Cranford Street between Innes Road and Berwick Street

The Project Manager, Engagement Advisor and Planning & Delivery Transport Manager spoke to the attached presentation, providing information on the options for Cranford Street between Innes Road and Berwick Street before the public consultation.



The information session traversed:

- Background to the earlier clearway proposal not being supported by key stakeholders at that time and peak-hour bus lane trialled since 2021.
- Options investigated and determined appropriate for consultation at this time.
- Additional changes that apply to all options – safety improvements considered.
- Bus patronage information and traffic modelling of travel times and traffic volumes.
- Consultation tactics and structure.

The Board sought:

- Information on whether T2 lanes have been effective in Auckland.
- That clarity be provided in the consultation around initial T2 enforcement issues.
- Engagement with local schools, with direct approaches around joining in with their events being explored.
- Staff to supply safety audit before the consultation.
- Access to the previous feedback from the previous consultation around T2 lane.
