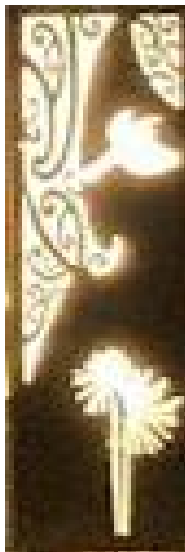

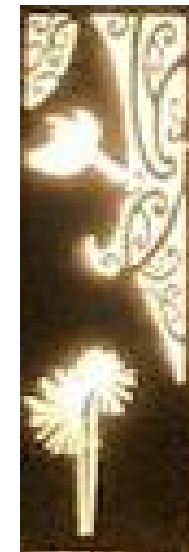

Problems

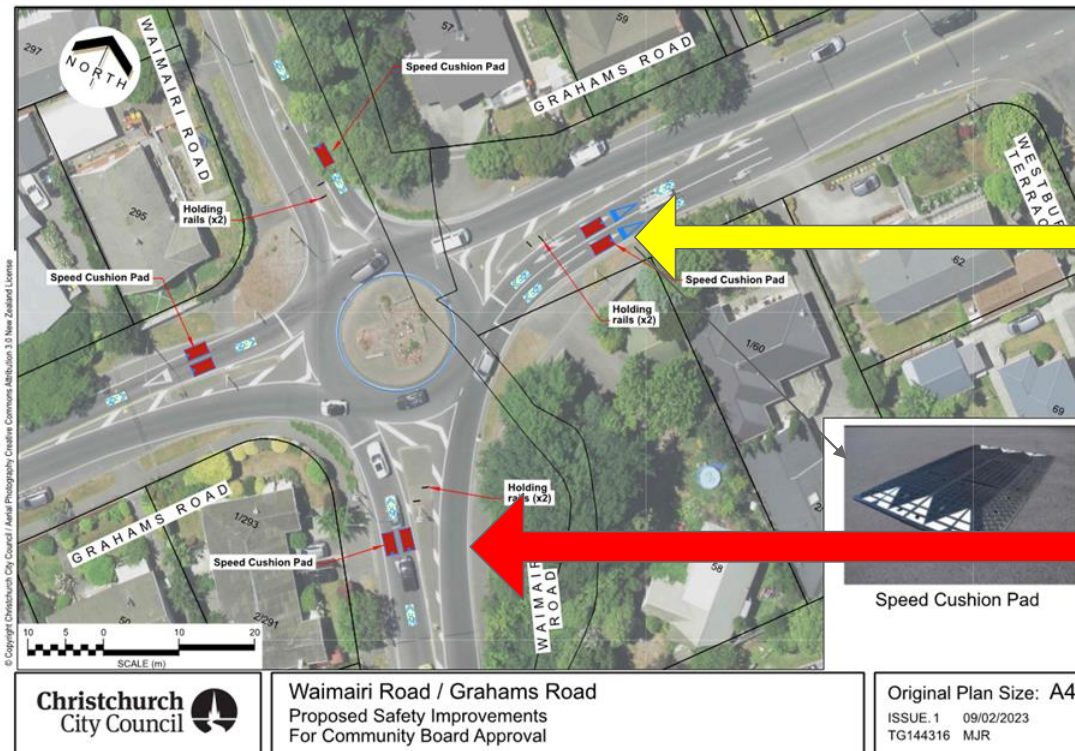
- *Cars drive too fast*
- *It's difficult to cross*
- *People can get hit trying to cross*
- *Some vehicles don't correctly use their indicators so pedestrians don't know which direction they are going in.*

Interviews with daily users

- *The speed cushion pads have helped slow traffic*
- *The yellow handles have little impact. They are not strong enough and have been bent by cars, or broken completely.*
- *Near misses have occurred*
- *If you're cycling or even using a scooter it's nearly impossible to get through at rush hours :
8.00-9am and 3-3.30pm*

Our wishes

- *Permanent speed bumps or a raised entry and exit for the roundabout*
- *Pedestrian crossings across all entry and exit points*
- *Education for children about how to cross the roundabout safely, and to be mindful of drivers not using their indicators correctly*
- *Clear signage saying 'Slow, children crossing'*
