The agenda was dealt with in the following order.

1. Apologies Ngā Whakapāha

An apology for absence was received from James Gough and apologies for early departure were received from Sam MacDonald and Nicola McCormick.

2. Project update - Local Play Space Renewals

The Project Manager briefed the Board on upcoming local play space renewals. The briefing covered:

- Toorak Reserve, Ferrier Park, Ryeland Reserve and Daresbury Park play spaces are scheduled for renewal.
- The proposed consultation approach, including the pre-engagement conducted over the summer holidays.
- Anticipated timeframes for the play space designs to be confirmed and delivered.

3. Three Waters Programme

The Head of Three Waters briefed the Board on forecast Three Waters expenditure in the draft Annual Plan, including:

- The proportions of the budget going towards replacing existing assets, meeting additional demand and changes to levels of service.
- A summary of the key projects that make up the capital programme and proposed changes to delivery timeframes.
