


## Waimairi Rd / Grahams Rd Roundabout









## **Problems**

- Cars drive too fast
- It's difficult to cross
- People can get hit trying to cross
- Some vehicles don't correctly use their indicators so pedestrians don't know which direction they are going in.






- The speed cushion pads have helped slow traffic
- The yellow handles have little impact. They are not strong enough and have been bent by cars, or broken completely.
- Near misses have occurred
- If you're cycling or even using a scooter it's nearly impossible to get through at rush hours:
  8.00-9am and 3-3.30pm





- Permanent speed bumps or a raised entry and exit for the roundabout
- Pedestrian crossings across all entry and exit points
- Education for children about how to cross the roundabout safely, and to be mindful of drivers not using their indicators correctly
- Clear signage saying 'Slow, children crossing'









- People drive too fast. It is scary.
