1. Apologies Ngā Whakapāha

2. Canterbury A&P Association Board Update

Presented by: Sir David Carter - Board Chair, Peter Engel – Director, and Ethan Hill – Director

- Sir David Carter introduced Peter and Ethan, and discussed the recent changes to the Board. Discussed Show Week and importance of promoting opportunities to ensure continuous development of the rural and urban relationship. Discussed upcoming show week.
- Peter Engel discussed strategy.
- Councillor Scandrett requested confirmation on ownership of the event. Peter confirmed health and safety and traffic management ownership still falls on them.
- Councillor Scandrett Discussed the synchronicity of show week. David notes believes that this is important and requires embracing from the entire city. Preference for “Canterbury A&P”
- Councillor Henstock requested confirmation in the role which staff have had in the redevelopment and what else may be required from Staff. Peter confirmed that relationship with Andrew Rutledge has been important. Note reached agreement on financial support. Andrew Rutledge agreed to come on to the board as an advisor.
- Councillor Henstock sought further confirmation on funding support. Peter Engel’s provided details on this. Andrew Rutledge confirmed city identity fund.
- Councillor Barber raised prior uncertainty and plans for attendance. Sir David Carter notes that there has been a large amount of publicity, keen to put past behind them, positive focus on the future.
- Councillor Johanson, raised the royal show. Sir David Carter discussed, note there is no focus on placing a label on this year.
