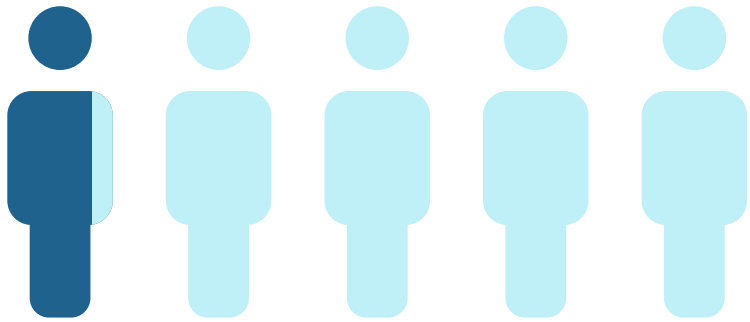

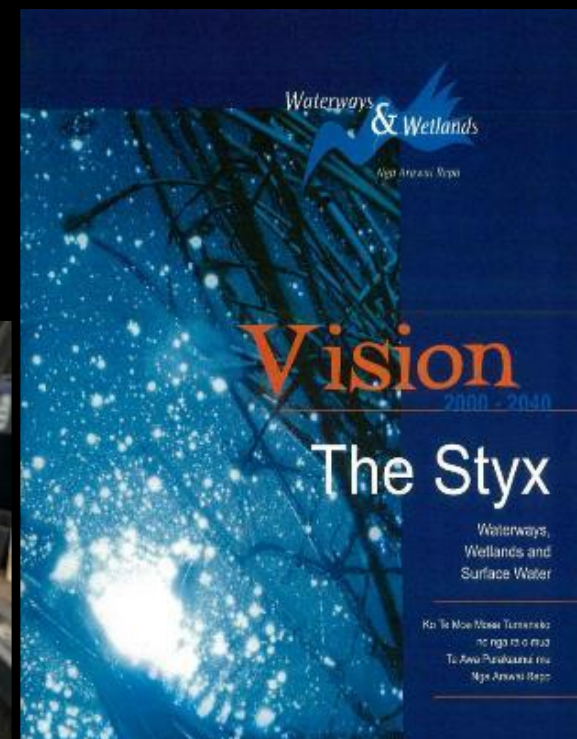

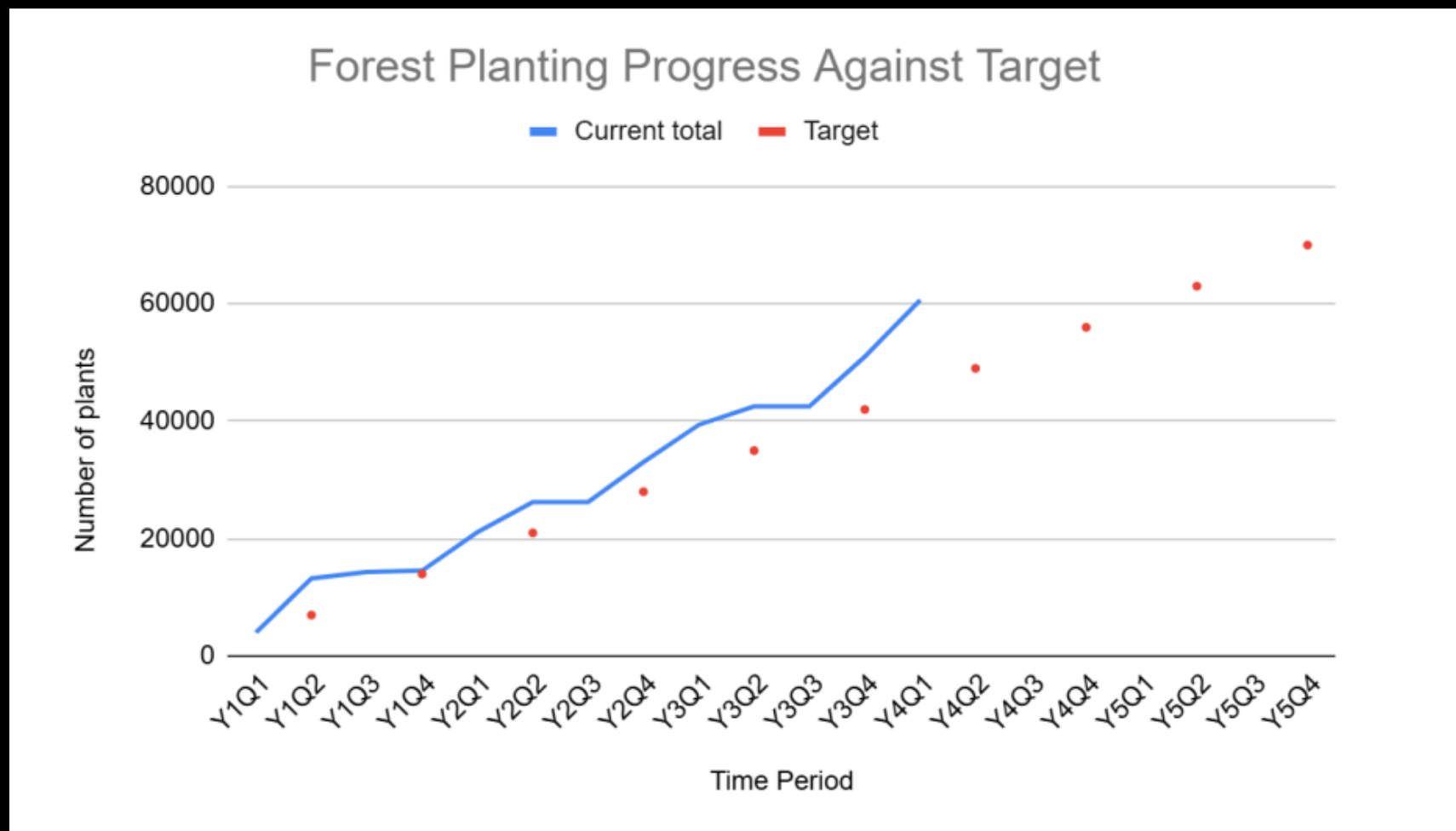


Project Kōtare

- MfE Funded via Freshwater Improvement Fund
- \$4.25M over five years
 - Staff & resources

 - Forest restoration
 - Willow *et al.* control
 - Waterway fencing
