## 5. Council submission on the Land Transport Management (Time of Use Charging) Amendment Bill

- This legislation was signalled in the Government Policy Statement on land transport 2024.
- Staff will circulate draft submission for feedback.
- Councillor Templeton has asked to recommend wording change from scheme regions to scheme districts.
- Councillor Fields would like exemptions for people where it is not practical (for example those who live in Akaroa).
- Staff have asked for clarification whether representatives would be staff or elected members.
