3. Steadfast - Cass Bay Residents' Association Building Project (Site Visit)

The Board attended a site visit to Steadfast, Cass Bay. The Cass Bay Residents' Association Chairperson, Jenny Healey, and Association committee member Noeline Allan shared an update on the Association's project at Steadfast. The Board members were advised:

- The site previously approved for community consultation is cost-prohibitive to build on and would not provide desired aspects such as an accessible outdoor space to users.
- The Residents' Association would like consideration of the garage building being demolished and approval given to enable them to proceed with raising funds to build a new multi-use community facility on or near to the site where the garage sits currently.
- They require site approval prior to being able to approach potential funders.
