



My name is Karenna and I am currently on medical benefit living in a Kianga Ora home in Spreydon.

I get rather bored so I have taken it upon myself to help people that cannot do home handy jobs and garden things which as long as are in my scope I will fix.

I also have some health issues and certainly don't have any discretionary income and this limits how much I can currently do to help people.

I currently mow both my neighbours' grass and am working with them in their gardens (both are beneficiaries and both have health issues and cannot keep up with the gardens and lawns in their KO homes).

I am also working with a young lady that has Fibromialgia to sort her property, gardens and general maintenance but I have a major issue with the cost of removing all the garden waste.

Now as I have mentioned I am a beneficiary and unfortunately live week to week on my benefit and would like to be able to dump all the extra green waste I generate as I tidy up my neighbours and others homes and this is not possible just in the current green waste bins through council pick up.

This brings me to the actual point of my contacting you, Is there any way you could arrange for FREE or REDUCED cost for me to dump the green waste anywhere please?.

This issue is holding me back from doing more as I and a lot of the people I help just don`t have the funds to get this done.

Maybe I should have mentioned that I do this for free, as I am slow due to my health issues but thorough and would like to be able to clear out as I go as leaving piles of waste when they cannot get rid of it isn't really achieving much in the whole unfortunately.
