2. Canterbury Water Management Strategy Zone Committee Review

3. Te Kaha Surrounding Streets Re-Consultation - Setting Speed Limits Rule

This item was not recorded owing to a change in location.

Presenters: Jacob Bradbury – Manager Planning and Delivery, Transport and Hannah Ballantyne - Senior Engagement Advisor

- Staff provided an overview of issue and consultation.
- Councillor Harrison-Hunt – modelling will be clarified and referenced.
- Councillor Fields – Is status quo available – it is. Consultation is primarily for changes.
- Councillor Johanson – Are speed humps planned for Barbadoes Street? No. There was an increased risk in flooding.
- Councillor Johanson – can we get updated traffic data? It would be impracticable owing to all the current traffic management.
- Staff understand the difficulties of varied speed limits. Working with mechanisms of rules in place.
- Councillor Scandrett – support this approach for event management and safety.
- Staff provided other sites with similar issues.
- Antigua Street - Operating speed will be low and cyclists will be separated.
- Worcester Street – Link to MCR – lower speed limit.
- Nor'West Arc – under construction – slower speed limit.
- Councillor MacDonald - suggest staff bring a report to Council and they would make a decision.
