2. Burwood & Mairehau Intersection Improvement - Pre-consultation Information Session

Council officers in attendance provided the Board with two proposed options for the Burwood and Mairehau intersection which are to either upgrade to the existing roundabout or signalising the intersection.

Concerns were raised about the implementation of a raised pedestrian crossing outside Burwood Hospital. Staff in attendance reassured that consultation had occurred and the hospital was in favour of the pedestrian crossing.

It was noted that:

- Pre-consultation/early engagement with the community is a priority due to the potential loss of on street parking.
- Postponing the high impact section of the route until a later stage to address it properly (potential use of parks land/resealing verges).
- There is a total budget of \$557,000.
