The Manager Operations – Community Parks Development provided the Board with the attached presentation on the Community Parks Rolling Renewal Programme, setting out:

The Operations Manager addressed the Board's questions, including in relation to:

- Soft fall surface replacement
- Rubbish bin replacement/provision
- How playability and like for like replacement is assessed
