#### **Community Board Information Session/Workshop Notes**

The Manager Operations – Community Parks Development provided the Board with the attached presentation on the Community Parks Rolling Renewal Programme, setting out:

- What the rolling renewal programme is
- · How the Parks Unit determine what is renewed
- An example of green asset renewal
- An example of playground renewal

The Operations Manager addressed the Board's questions, including in relation to:

- Soft fall surface replacement
- Rubbish bin replacement/provision
- How playability and like for like replacement is assessed
- Getting variation / points of difference between parks in an area
- Correction to agenda attachment in respect of hard surface renewal for Styx River Conservation Reserve – Cycleway: incomplete bracketed sentence should say (not delivered FY25). This project carried over to FY26. Can also top up gravel on path around river.
- Reviewing hard surface renewals done recently for the extent they need redoing as scheduled

- Interface and coordination of works at Fortune Playground
- Westminster Street depot
