Development process

- Picked up by new Whitiora staff-base July 2024
- Full audit and review of available direct and related material
- Document function and structural research
- Wananga and workshops with Rūnanga reps and tribal academics
- Integration of findings
- Compilation of drafts for circulation and comment



Goals

- First Strategic Goal: Reserve infrastructure deficit both identified and future planning aligned with targets set in conjunction with hapū.
- Second Strategic Goal: Planning rules aligned on reserve and off with hapū aspirations.
- Third Strategic Goal: Fiscal and infrastructural situation, and proposed arrangements for kāinga nohoanga and commercial entities.
- Fourth Strategic Goal: Development of a schedule of projects between Rūnanga and Greater Christchurch Partners.



Schedule of projects between Rūnanga and Greater Christchurch Partners

- Waimakariri District MR873 structural planning and other projects to give effect to principles of Canterbury Purchase Deed
- Christchurch District Urban Kāinga Nohoanga research, work with Rapaki Rūnanga and Māori Land-owners on Rapaki MR875
- Selwyn District Research K\u00e4inga Nohoanga provisions potential for Te Koroha
 / Ahuriri Lagoon Native Reserve 959 and 'off-reserve' options
- **Environment Canterbury**: Research giving effect to Canterbury Purchase Deed Principles via Water management and Kāinga Nohoanga development
