#### 1. Apologies Ngā Whakapāha

#### 2. Transport Operations Report (April - June 2025)

Presented by Stephen Wright - Manager Operations (Transport) and Jacob Bradbury - Manager Planning & Delivery (Transport)

- Staff presented the quarterly update on the Transport and Waste Unit.
- Councillors asked questions about: service caps; sealing trials; street trees; footpaths and potholes; lighting' speedhumps; and fines.

## 3. Council submission - Local Government (System Improvements) Amendment Bill
