## 4. Hornby Local Area Plan and associated transport programmes

Council Planning and Engagement staff together with NZTA planning staff updated the Board on progress developing the Hornby Local Area Plan (LAP) and interrelated major transport projects and programmes. They covered:

- the first phase of the Hornby LAP project and approach to engagement, including the input, support and direction sought from the Community Board.
- three transport programmes: Mass Rapid Transit Route Protection, Public Transport Futures, and NZTA's SH1 Hornby Access and Development Strategic Transport Plan.
- the proposed ‘turn up and go’ rapid transit service that will run along a city spine from Hornby to Belfast, via the central city and builds on the goal of increasing patronage from the Public Transport Futures programme.
- NZ Transport Agency programme of improvements to the state highway network through Hornby and the airport surrounds to manage growth and increased freight movements.
