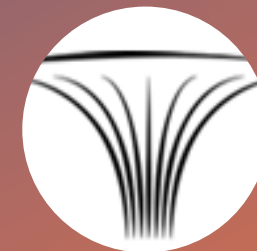

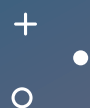








# Northwood Boulevard connection with Johns Road

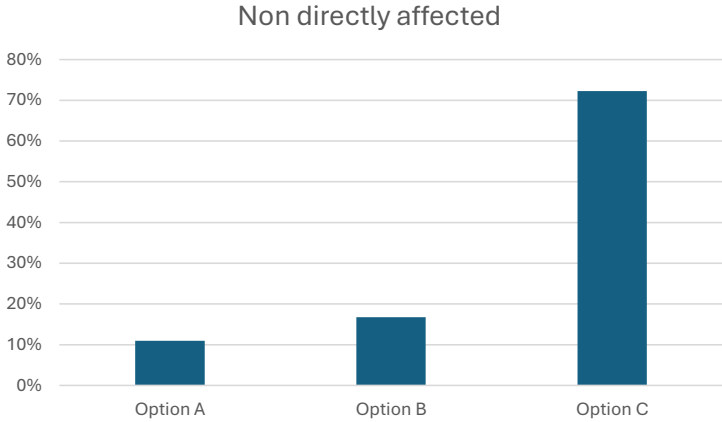

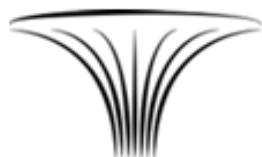
## Non Directly affected within the original subdivision
