1. Detail Te Whakamahuki

Timing	This workshop is expected to last for 45 minutes.
Purpose / Origin of the Workshop	The purpose of the workshop is to provide the Community Board with an update and high-level programme for Bromley Roads – Package 2.
Background	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Consultation was run in June 2023 to collect community feedback on Way Safer Streets.• In 2024, the Bromley Transport Action Plan was developed (with consultation in October/November 2024 on the draft Action Plan and plan for Keighleys Road and Bromley Road). The first suite of projects was approved by the Community Board on 9 December 2024 and completed by mid-2025.• Construction is complete on Priority 1 works and post construction monitoring shows a reduction in speed across all treatment sites, now being consistent with the 30km/h posted speed limit. Traffic volumes have decreased on some roads, remained unchanged on others, while there is an increase on another couple. <i>Detailed information/maps will be shared as part of the presentation.</i>• Project team have had an initial meeting with Bromley Community Association in November and have gathered some informal feedback through the Association.• Project team have reviewed the Bromley Transport Action Plan, noting the works completed to date, and schemes approved by Council in September 2023, to determine a way forward.
