Dear Banks Peninsula residents,

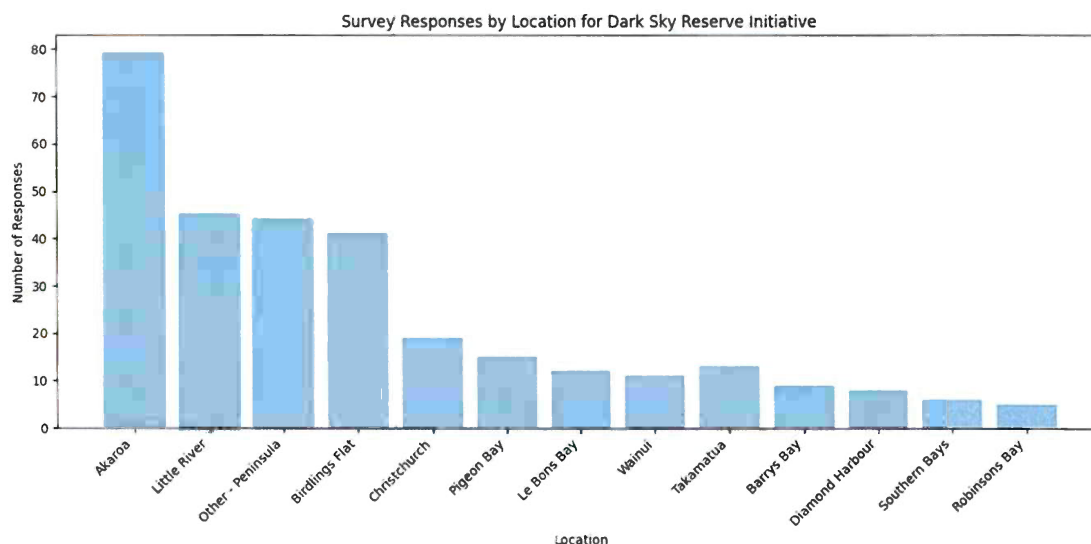
I'm pleased to share the results of our recent community survey regarding the proposed Dark Sky Reserve initiative.
