The agenda was dealt with in the following order.

1. Apologies Ngā Whakapāha

The Board received an apology from James Gough.

2. Food Resilience Policy and Action Plan Review

The Policy & Project Advisor briefed the Community Board on the planned review of the Council Food Resilience Policy. During the discussion, the following points were raised:

- It would be helpful to have clear direction about the Council's role in food resilience.
- Board members suggested advocating for more Home Economics education in schools.
- Board members suggested finding ways to make it easier for community groups to establish community gardens.
- Board members suggested a policy of having an edible plant or tree in every Council park.
- Board members suggested that the policy takes into account the success stories from different cultures in relation to food resilience, food production and cooking skills.
