The agenda was dealt with in the following order.

## **1. Apologies Ngā Whakapāha**

Apologies for absence were received from Tyla Harrison-Hunt and Joseph Fullerton.

## **2. Waipuna Halswell-Hornby-Riccarton Draft Community Board Plan Engagement Feedback**

Bailey Peterson, Community Governance Manager presented an overview of the feedback received, and highlighted key themes emerging from the community feedback.

Board members discussed the feedback received and agreed on the following changes to the draft plan:

- Alteration of the *Vision statements* by inclusion of community facilities as a means of supporting the physical, social, and emotional wellbeing of residents.
- Addition of a Board vision that values securing easy access to a safe chlorine free water station for residents in Southwest Christchurch.
- Inclusion of a statement recognising that communities have their own visions for their communities and the Board's commitment to encouraging and supporting the attainment of these visions where appropriate.
- Addition of an explanation of Board priorities as *projects requiring progress* and of Board's usual business.
- Replacing the Halswell priority regarding accessible chlorine free community water station *with a priority for renewal of the section of Cashmere Road between Sutherlands Road and the Halswell Quarry*.
- Communication of the changes to the final plan from the draft and the reasons for these.
