## **2. Transport Roadshow 2026**

The Head of Transport, supported by the Manager Operations, Manager City Streets Maintenance, and Manager Planning & Delivery, presented to the Community Board to explain the structure, role and functions of the Council Transport Unit.

Following the staff presentation, Board members discussed:

- How we can improve crash and near-miss reporting, including the possibility of adopting Marlborough District Council's approach to an online report a near miss form and heatmap.
- The possibility of attracting corporate sponsors to support adult cycle safety classes so more resources are available for school programmes.
- Comparing 'whole of life' costs of asphalt and chipseal when determining what to use for resurfacing.
- The possibility of putting together a package of small projects from the potential projects register and funding them through the Annual Plan.
- How to progress the Belfast Road priority in the Community Board Plan.
- Upcoming resurfacing and renewal projects and how to ensure the most efficient delivery.
