Part C

That the Waipapa Papanui-Innes-Central Community Board:

1. Receives the information in the Bealey Avenue & Intersections - Proposed No Stopping Restrictions Report.
2. Notes that the decision in this report are assessed as low significance based on the Christchurch City Council's Significance and Engagement Policy.
3. Under Clause 6(2) of the Christchurch City Council Traffic and Parking Bylaw 2017 revokes any previous resolutions pertaining to traffic controls made pursuant to any bylaw to the extent that they are in conflict with the parking or stopping restrictions described in resolutions 4 to 27 below.

Caledonian Road

4. Approves that, in accordance with Clause 7 of the Christchurch City Council Traffic and Parking Bylaw 2017, the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the northern side of Bealey Avenue, commencing at its intersection with Caledonian Road and extending in a westerly direction for a distance of 22 metres, as detailed on Attachment A (Plan 1440001-1, Issue 2, dated 4/5/2026) to the report on the meeting agenda.
5. Approves that, in accordance with Clause 7 of the Christchurch City Council Traffic and Parking Bylaw 2017, the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the western side of Caledonian Road, commencing at its intersection with Bealey Avenue and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of 20 metres, as detailed on Attachment A (Plan 1440001-1, Issue 2, dated 4/5/2026) to the report on the meeting agenda.
6. Approves that, in accordance with Clause 7 of the Christchurch City Council Traffic and Parking Bylaw 2017, the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the northern side of Bealey Avenue, commencing at its intersection with Caledonian Road and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 53 metres, as detailed on Attachment A (Plan 1440001-1, Issue 2, dated 4/5/2026) to the report on the meeting agenda.
7. Approves that, in accordance with Clause 7 of the Christchurch City Council Traffic and Parking Bylaw 2017, the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the eastern side of Caledonian Road, commencing at its intersection with Bealey Avenue and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of seven metres, as detailed on Attachment A (Plan 1440001-1, Issue 2, dated 4/5/2026) to the report on the meeting agenda.
8. Approves that, in accordance with Clause 7 of the Christchurch City Council Traffic and Parking Bylaw 2017, the parking of motor vehicles be restricted to a maximum period of thirty minutes on the eastern side of Caledonian Road, commencing seven metres from its intersection with Bealey Avenue and extending in a northerly direction for a distance

of nine metres, as detailed on Attachment A (Plan 1440001-1, Issue 2, dated 4/5/2026) to the report on the meeting agenda.

9. Approves that, in accordance with Clause 7 of the Christchurch City Council Traffic and Parking Bylaw 2017, the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the eastern side of Caledonian Road, commencing 16 metres from its intersection with Bealey Avenue and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of 18 metres, as detailed on Attachment A (Plan 1440001-1, Issue 2, dated 4/5/2026) to the report on the meeting agenda.

Bishop Street

10. Approves that, in accordance with Clause 7 of the Christchurch City Council Traffic and Parking Bylaw 2017, the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the northern side of Bealey Avenue, commencing at its intersection with Bishop Street and extending in a westerly direction for a distance of 22 metres, as detailed on Attachment B (Plan 1440001-2, Issue 2, dated 4/5/2026) to the report on the meeting agenda.
11. Approves that, in accordance with Clause 7 of the Christchurch City Council Traffic and Parking Bylaw 2017, the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the western side of Bishop Street, commencing at its intersection with Bealey Avenue and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of 17 metres, as detailed on Attachment B (Plan 1440001-2, Issue 2, dated 4/5/2026) to the report on the meeting agenda.
12. Approves that, in accordance with Clause 7 of the Christchurch City Council Traffic and Parking Bylaw 2017, the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the northern side of Bealey Avenue, commencing at its intersection with Bishop Street and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 14 metres, as detailed on Attachment B (Plan 1440001-2, Issue 2, dated 4/5/2026) to the report on the meeting agenda.
13. Approves that, in accordance with Clause 7 of the Christchurch City Council Traffic and Parking Bylaw 2017, the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the eastern side of Bishop Street, commencing at its intersection with Bealey Avenue and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of 17 metres, as detailed on Attachment B (Plan 1440001-2, Issue 2, dated 4/5/2026) to the report on the meeting agenda.

Packe Street

14. Approves that, in accordance with Clause 7 of the Christchurch City Council Traffic and Parking Bylaw 2017, the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the northern side of Bealey Avenue, commencing at its intersection with Packe Street and extending in a westerly direction for a distance of 20 metres, as detailed on Attachment C (Plan 1440001-3, Issue 2, dated 4/5/2026) to the report on the meeting agenda.
15. Approves that, in accordance with Clause 7 of the Christchurch City Council Traffic and Parking Bylaw 2017, the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the western side of Packe Street, commencing at its intersection with Bealey Avenue and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of 13 metres, as detailed on Attachment C (Plan 1440001-3, Issue 2, dated 4/5/2026) to the report on the meeting agenda.

Geraldine Street

16. Approves that, in accordance with Clause 7 of the Christchurch City Council Traffic and Parking Bylaw 2017, the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the northern side of Bealey Avenue, commencing at its intersection with Geraldine Street and extending in a westerly direction for a distance of 18 metres, as detailed on Attachment D (Plan 1440001-4, Issue 2, dated 4/5/2026) to the report on the meeting agenda.

17. Approves that, in accordance with Clause 7 of the Christchurch City Council Traffic and Parking Bylaw 2017, the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the western side of Geraldine Street, commencing at its intersection with Bealey Avenue and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of six metres, as detailed on Attachment D (Plan 1440001-4, Issue 2, dated 4/5/2026) to the report on the meeting agenda.
18. Approves that, in accordance with Clause 7 of the Christchurch City Council Traffic and Parking Bylaw 2017, the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the northern side of Bealey Avenue, commencing at its intersection with Geraldine Street and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 15 metres, as detailed on Attachment D (Plan 1440001-4, Issue 2, dated 4/5/2026) to the report on the meeting agenda.
19. Approves that, in accordance with Clause 7 of the Christchurch City Council Traffic and Parking Bylaw 2017, the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the eastern side of Geraldine Street commencing at its intersection with Bealey Avenue and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of six metres, as detailed on Attachment D (Plan 1440001-4, Issue 2, dated 4/5/2026) to the report on the meeting agenda.

Champion Street

20. Approves that, in accordance with Clause 7 of the Christchurch City Council Traffic and Parking Bylaw 2017, the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the northern side of Bealey Avenue, commencing at its intersection with Champion Street and extending in a westerly direction for a distance of 19 metres, as detailed on Attachment E (Plan 1440001-5, Issue 2, dated 4/5/2026) to the report on the meeting agenda.
21. Approves that, in accordance with Clause 7 of the Christchurch City Council Traffic and Parking Bylaw 2017, the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the western side of Champion Street, commencing at its intersection with Bealey Avenue and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of 12 metres, as detailed on Attachment E (Plan 1440001-5, Issue 2, dated 4/5/2026) to the report on the meeting agenda.
22. Approves that, in accordance with Clause 7 of the Christchurch City Council Traffic and Parking Bylaw 2017, the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the northern side of Bealey Avenue, commencing at its intersection with Champion Street and extending to its intersection with Whitmore Street, as detailed on Attachment E (Plan 1440001-5, Issue 2, dated 4/5/2026) to the report on the meeting agenda.
23. Approves that, in accordance with Clause 7 of the Christchurch City Council Traffic and Parking Bylaw 2017, the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the eastern side of Champion Street, commencing at its intersection with Bealey Avenue and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 13 metres, as detailed on Attachment E (Plan 1440001-5, Issue 2, dated 4/5/2026) to the report on the meeting agenda.

Churchill Street

24. Approves that, in accordance with Clause 7 of the Christchurch City Council Traffic and Parking Bylaw 2017, the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the southern side of Bealey Avenue, commencing at its intersection with Churchill Street and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 19 metres, as detailed on Attachment E (Plan 1440001-5, Issue 2, dated 4/5/2026) to the report on the meeting agenda.
25. Approves that, in accordance with Clause 7 of the Christchurch City Council Traffic and Parking Bylaw 2017, the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the eastern side of Churchill Street, commencing at its intersection with Bealey Avenue and extending in a southerly direction for a distance of ten metres, as detailed on

Attachment E (Plan 1440001-5, Issue 2, dated 4/5/2026) to the report on the meeting agenda.

26. Approves that, in accordance with Clause 7 of the Christchurch City Council Traffic and Parking Bylaw 2017, the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the southern side of Bealey Avenue, commencing at its intersection with Churchill Street and extending in an westerly direction for a distance of 19 metres, as detailed on Attachment E (Plan 1440001-5, Issue 2, dated 4/5/2026) to the report on the meeting agenda.
27. Approves that, in accordance with Clause 7 of the Christchurch City Council Traffic and Parking Bylaw 2017, the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the western side of Churchill Street, commencing at its intersection with Bealey Avenue and extending in a southerly direction for a distance of ten metres, as detailed on Attachment E (Plan 1440001-5, Issue 2, dated 4/5/2026) to the report on the meeting agenda.
