## **4. Public Forum / Te Huinga Whānui**

### **Part B**

#### **4.1 Heaton Street and Carlton Mill Road Bus Stops**

Philip Haythornthwaite, on behalf of the Disabled Persons Association – Christchurch And Districts, addressed the Board regarding safety concerns at bus stops on Heaton Street, Carlton Mill Road and Papanui Road.

Mr Haythornthwaite expressed concern that bus stop 36807 on Heaton Street, by Elmwood Park, did not meet the approved Bus Stop Guidelines and asked that no stopping lines be installed on both the approach side, for a distance of eight metres, and the departure side, for a distance of four metres, of the bus stop boxing.

Mr Haythornthwaite also expressed concern over footpath subsidence and a disused vehicular kerb cut-down at bus stop 10660 on Carlton Mill Road between Harper Avenue and Rossall Street.

Further, Mr Haythornthwaite asked that the roadside kerb be replaced where there are dis-used vehicle kerb cut-downs on other bus stops in Carlton Mill Road and outside St George's Hospital on Papanui Road.

The Waimāero/Fendalton-Waimairi-Harewood Community Board decided to refer the concerns raised by Mr Haythornthwaite, on behalf of the Disabled Persons Association – Christchurch And Districts, regarding bus stops on Heaton Street, Carlton Mill Road and Papanui Road for investigation and a response back to the Community Board.

## 10. Proposed No Stopping Restrictions - Logistics Drive and Greywacke Road

**Community Board Resolved FWHB/2020/00031 (Original Officer Recommendation accepted without change)**

### Part C

That the Waimāero/Fendalton-Waimairi-Harewood Community Board resolved to:

2. Approve, pursuant to Clause 7 of the Christchurch City Council Traffic and Parking Bylaw 2017;
  - a. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the northern side of Logistics Drive commencing its intersection with Sawyers Arms Road, and extending in a westerly direction for a distance of 147 metres.
  - b. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the southern side of Logistics Drive commencing at a point 109 metres west of its intersection with Sawyers Arms Road, and extending in a westerly direction for a distance of 22 metres.
  - c. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the southern side of Logistics Drive commencing its intersection with Sawyers Arms Road, and extending in a westerly direction for a distance of 48 metres.
  - d. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the northern side of Greywacke Road commencing its intersection with Sawyers Arms Road, and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 117 metres.
  - e. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the southern side of Greywacke Road commencing at its intersection with Sawyers Arms Road, and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 120 metres.
3. Revoke any previous resolutions pertaining to traffic controls made pursuant to any bylaw to the extent that they are in conflict with the traffic controls described in this report.
4. Approve that these resolutions take effect when road markings that evidence the restrictions described in the agenda report are in place (or removed in the case of revocations).
