27. Central City Projects - High Street (Cashel to Tuam) and High Street Tram Extension - Procurement of Physical Works

Council Resolved CNCL/2021/00052

- 1. Resolves financial delegation to the Head of Transport to vary the Central City Roading Upgrades Contract (CN4600003299) subject to:
 - a. Completion of contractual negotiations with the preferred contractor to the satisfaction of the Head of Transport;
 - b. The contract value does not exceed \$23 million (total maximum change of \$8 million).
- 2. Approves the change of budget moving \$521,865 from FY25 to FY22 in Canterbury Multi-Use Arena Support Package project (ID 60253) and notes that this will be reflected in the final 2021-2031 Long Term Plan;
- 3. Resolves that this report remain public excluded until the project delivery is complete due to its commercial nature.
