On behalf of the St Albans History Group, may I request that the Community Board considers the placement of a suitable plaque on the former site of the St Albans Public Library. This site at 28 Dover Street is presently occupied by the Council owned Dover Courts. The history of this site includes that the Knightstown Mutual Improvement Society, founded in 1867, had a building erected as a meeting venue for the community. Eventually it became the St Albans Public Library until 1921 when the building was demolished and the facility moved to new premises in Colombo Street.
