





#### **Ethnic Communities Development Fund**

#### **ECDF Priorities**

## The Ethnic Communities COVID-19 Vaccine Uptake Fund

The Ministry of Health has made an extra \$1m available to support Ethnic Community vaccination against COVID-19.

The fund covers costs, such as venue hire, catering, transport costs, interpreters, collateral, translation of official information and wellbeing support.
