1. Notice of Motion to the Council

That the Council:

- 1. Notes with concern the apparent lack of controls and notification requirements specifically in regards to the storage and movement of shipping containers at depots within the district plan that are located in close proximity to residential zoning.
- 2. Seeks a report and/or advice on how and what changes could be considered to improve the District Plan by introducing additional controls and public notification requirements on the movement and storage of shipping containers at depots in close proximity to residential zones that address the potential adverse effects including (but not limited to):
 - a. safety
 - b. wind
 - c. noise and vibrations
 - d. lighting
 - e. visual intrusion
 - f. ecological, biodiversity and environmental impacts
 - g. hours of operation
 - h. bulk and height
 - i. dust
