## Location - Cashmere Highschool grounds opposite ampetheater



This is a model for the approximate size and position of the platform. The sustainability council has a long term plan to plant natives that would have once been found on these banks before Cashmere was settled.



## Who it benefits

- Provides an opportunity for students to spend more time with the stream
- Provides a space for students to reflect on the cultural narrative of the school
- Benefits the sustainability council because it provides them a place for students to test water quality
- Simple construction, no concrete, can be temporary, could be moved up and down stream
- Will have little to no impact on the environment. Ground screws have a longevity of 80 years
- Screws have been independantly verified for code of compliance strength analysis, in all three regimes of tensile, lateral and compressive strength.
