Rangatahi will benefit from this initiative which aims to address barriers and make golf accessible to a wider audience. The event will target rangatahi from the eastside of Otautahi, working specifically with local youth groups to encourage attendance from rangatahi that live in the east and south of the city.</p> <p>Working alongside YCD who have well over half of attendees identifying as Māori and Pasifika, the project aims to target these rangatahi to show them golf in a different light. This event will have rangatahi engaged providing them with opportunities to acquire new skills, build lasting relationships and develop a passion for healthy recreational activities.</p> <p>This project builds on the well-known and successful FRESH event series that YCD has been running for several years, having all the elements of a typical FRESH event, from a DJ, kai, barbers to competitions and prizes, but with the main activity of the event being Golf and mini-putt all free.</p> <p>Canterbury Golf alongside the event partners are investing approximately 32 hours of work towards this event. Canterbury Golf's objective following the event is to connect with more youth and youth groups to offer accessible opportunities to try golf and offer these sessions. Alongside this, Canterbury Golf run several Futures (junior) events across the year and would like to connect those that want to continue playing to these events (programmes run from Waimairi Beach and Bottle Lake Forest Clubs).</p> <p>Rational for staff recommendation is:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> YCD consistently provides fun, engaging and free events to engage vulnerable or at risk rangatahi. There is a strong collaborative approach with other organisations, funders, businesses and YCD.
