### Staff Assessment

Champ Nation Youth academy is a newly established Incorporated Society from January 2023. Champ Nation Youth Academy is a boxing based program for young individuals, particularly Maori and Pasifika youth aged 12-17 years old.

The programme is run termly at four times a year with three sessions available per week at no cost to the 34 individuals. The academy conducts goal-setting workshops, teaching rangatahi boxing and fitness basics. With regular attendance and dedication, rangatahi progress, gaining physical fitness, health and mental resilience while celebrating their culture and identity. Through boxing and fitness, it instils life skills, fosters a positive mindset and creates a supportive community for a successful transition into adulthood.

Champ Nation Youth Academy are seeking funding to cover the cost of salary/wages for three coaches (Head Coach and 2x Assistant Coaches), this will continue the great mahi in term four with the individuals that are currently registered to this program coming from the areas, Shirley Boys and Burwood x6, Riccarton and St Thomas area x8, local Hillmorton area x20.

Rational for staff recommendation is:

This free programme engages with vulnerable and at risk Rangatahi teaching them sports and life skills
